As a school district, we have been preparing for the 2019-2020 School Year Budget since December. There are still several major budgetary numbers that must be confirmed, such as state aid and health insurance; however, we are at that point in the budgetary process where we begin to make decisions that shape the final budget.

The Board of Education Finance Committee is focused on ensuring the public is informed about the budget and that the public has the opportunity to provide input into the final budget. Below are the meetings the Chesterfield Township Board of Education will hold related to the budget.

- Members of the public are encouraged to attend the board of education meeting to share your thoughts that you want to be considered as the finance committee works to finalize the preliminary 2019-2020 School Year Budget.

- The Finance Committee will meet again prior to the Monday, March 18<sup>th</sup> Board of Education Meeting to finalize the preliminary budget based on board of education and public feedback at the March 11<sup>th</sup> Board of Education Meeting.

- The Board of Education will vote to approve the preliminary 2019-2020 School Year Budget for submission to the Department of Education.


Late April/Early May (TBD)
