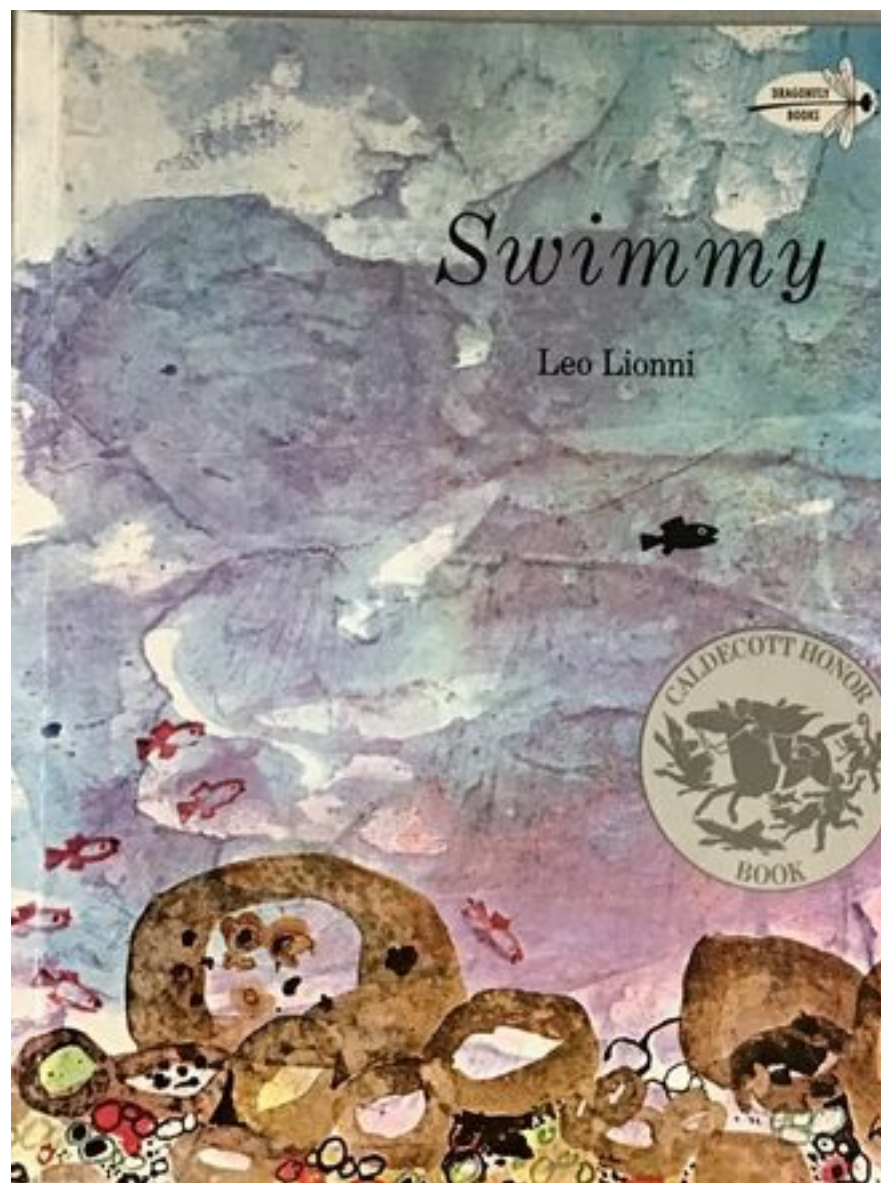

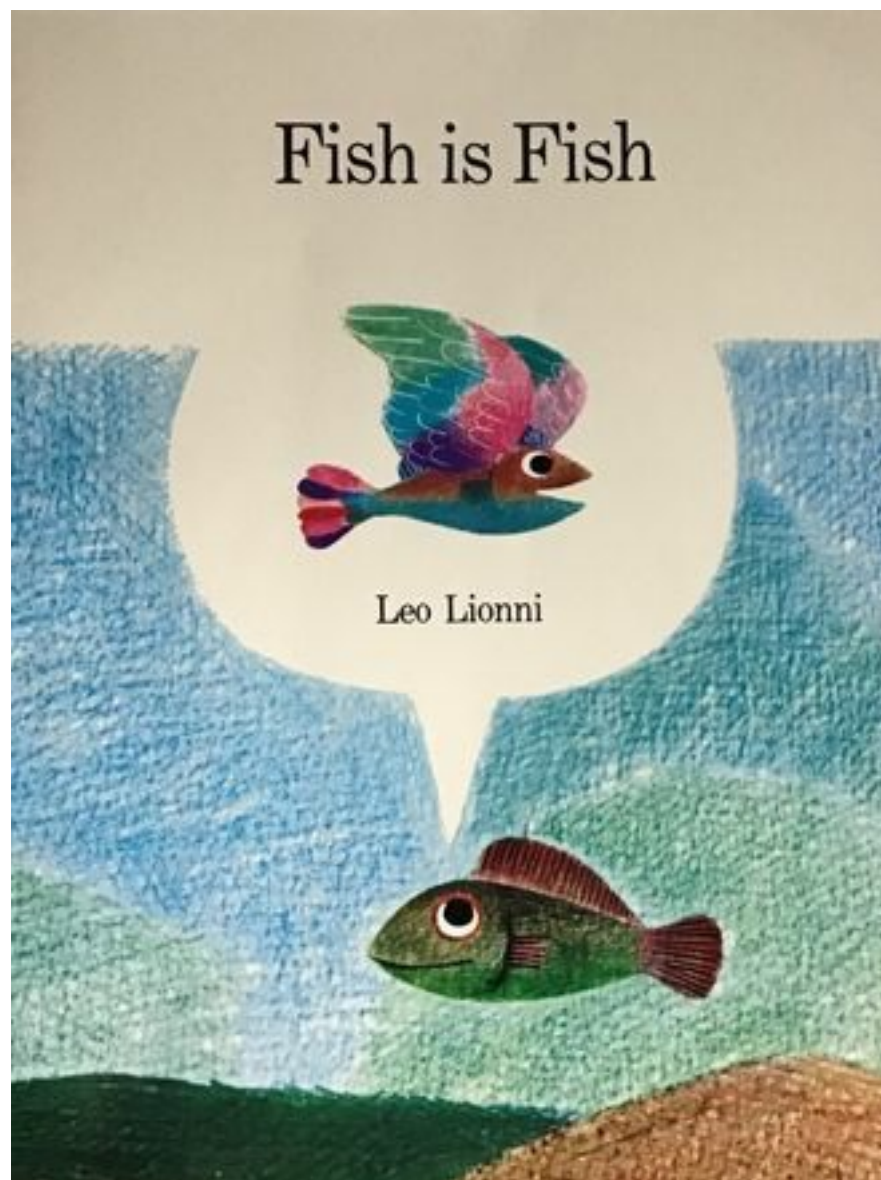
Swimmy by Leo Lionni

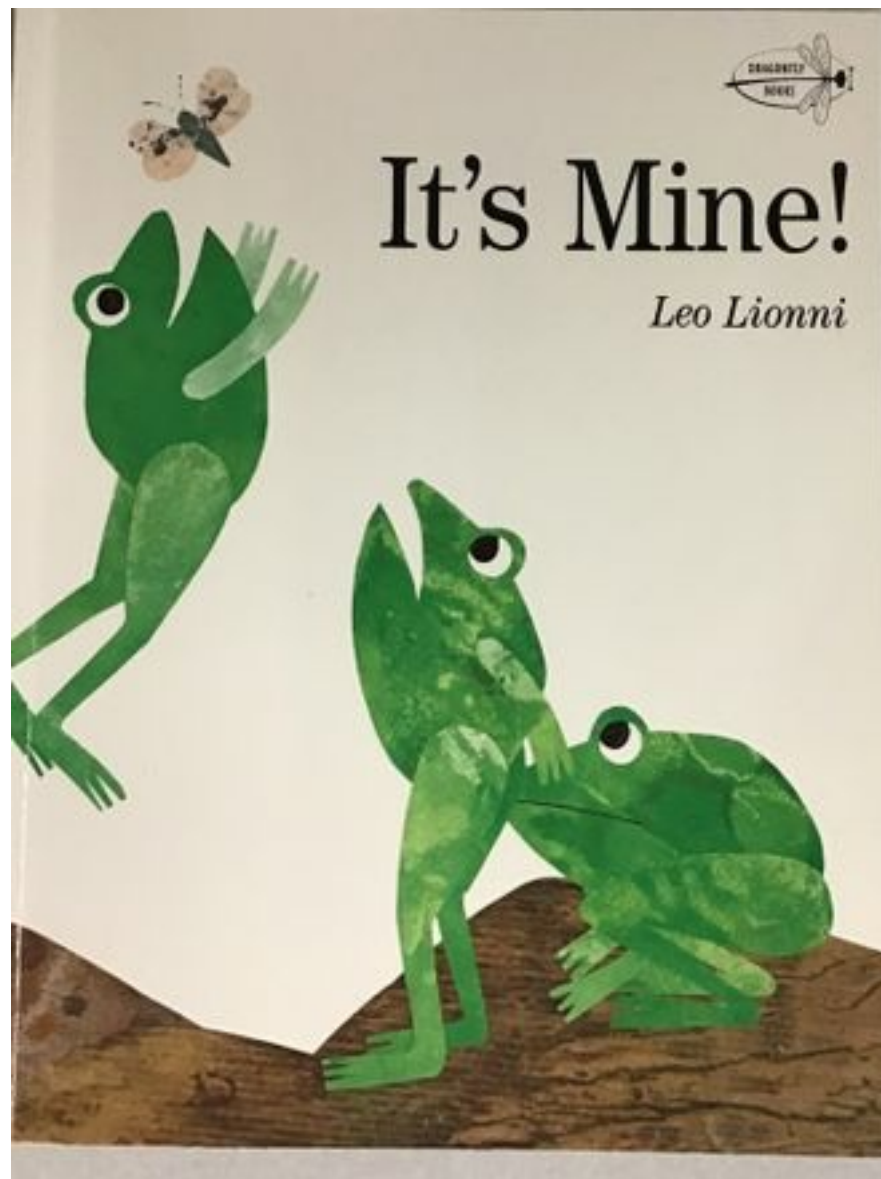


Fish is Fish by Leo Lionni

Here are some suggested activities to do with your child this week. Enjoy!

1. Give your child a magnet and various items (some that will stick and not stick to a magnet). Have your child explore the items to see what is magnetic. Talk about why.
2. Take pictures of of your child doing different things for a few days. Then show your child the pictures and talk about them. Ask who, what, where and why questions.
3. Give your child a bucket of water and a large paint brush. Your child can paint with water on the sidewalk.
4. Use a plastic grocery bag as a music scarf. Play music and have your child dance with the "scarf" (bag) to music. Talk about moving slow and fast. What happens when the scarf is thrown up in the air?
5. Use a deck of cards. Have your child pick a card, say the number and then do a movement that many times (pick a 5, hop on one foot five times). Your child can choose different movements.
