

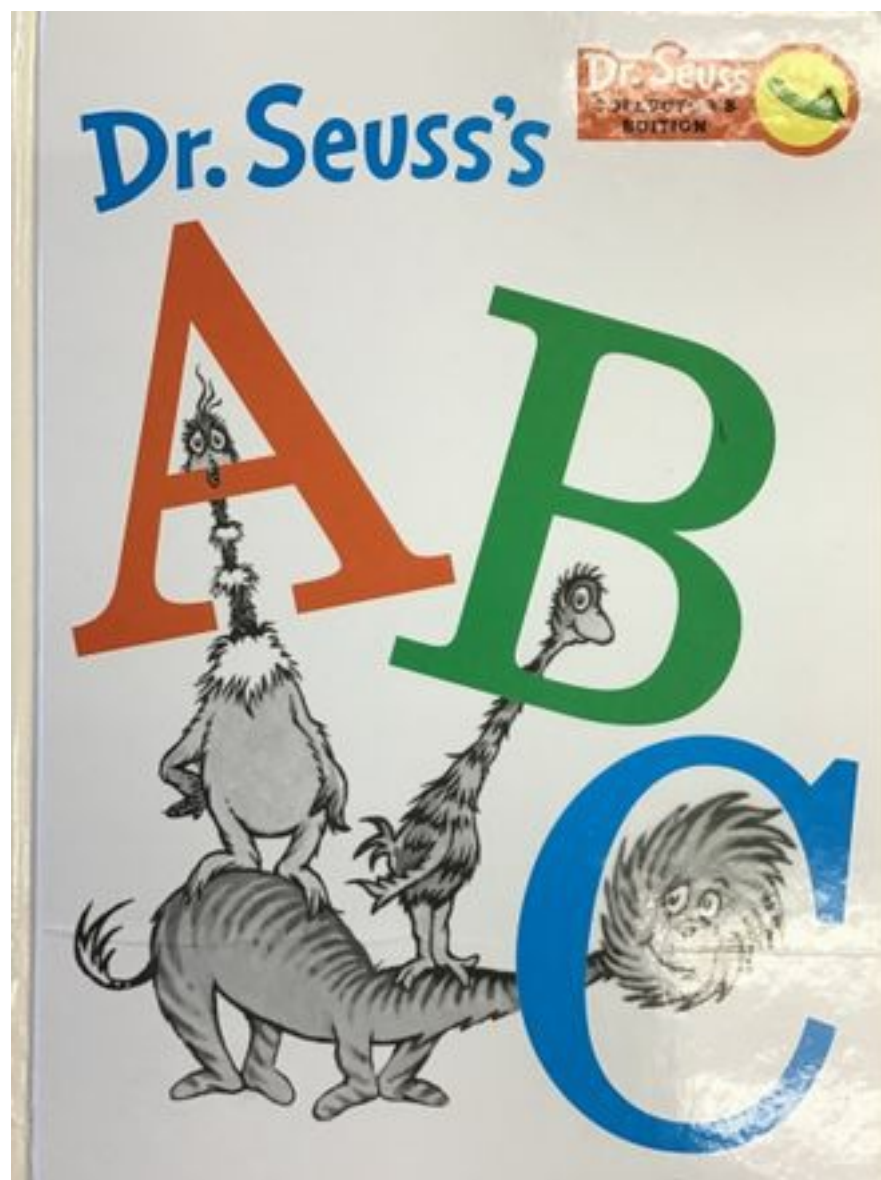


Week of March 1

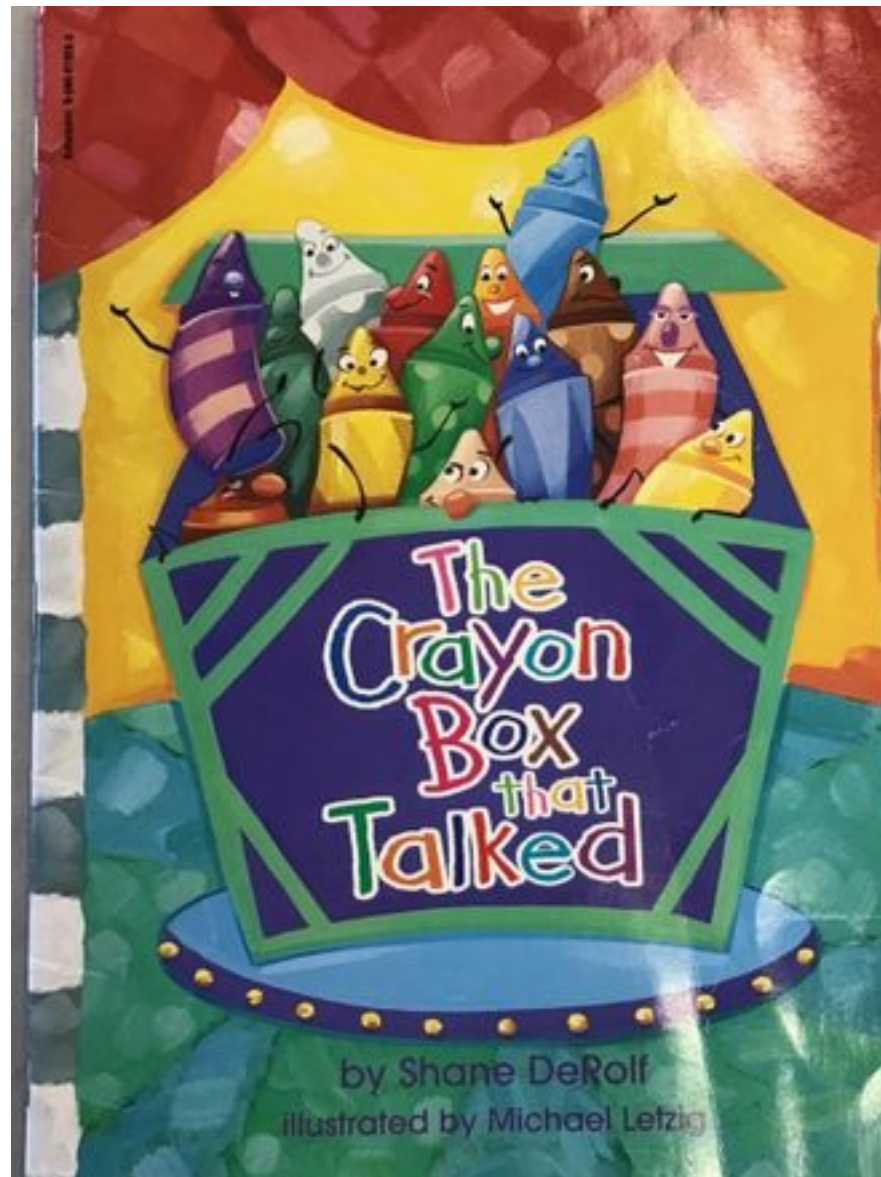


Dr. Seuss's ABC by Dr. Seuss

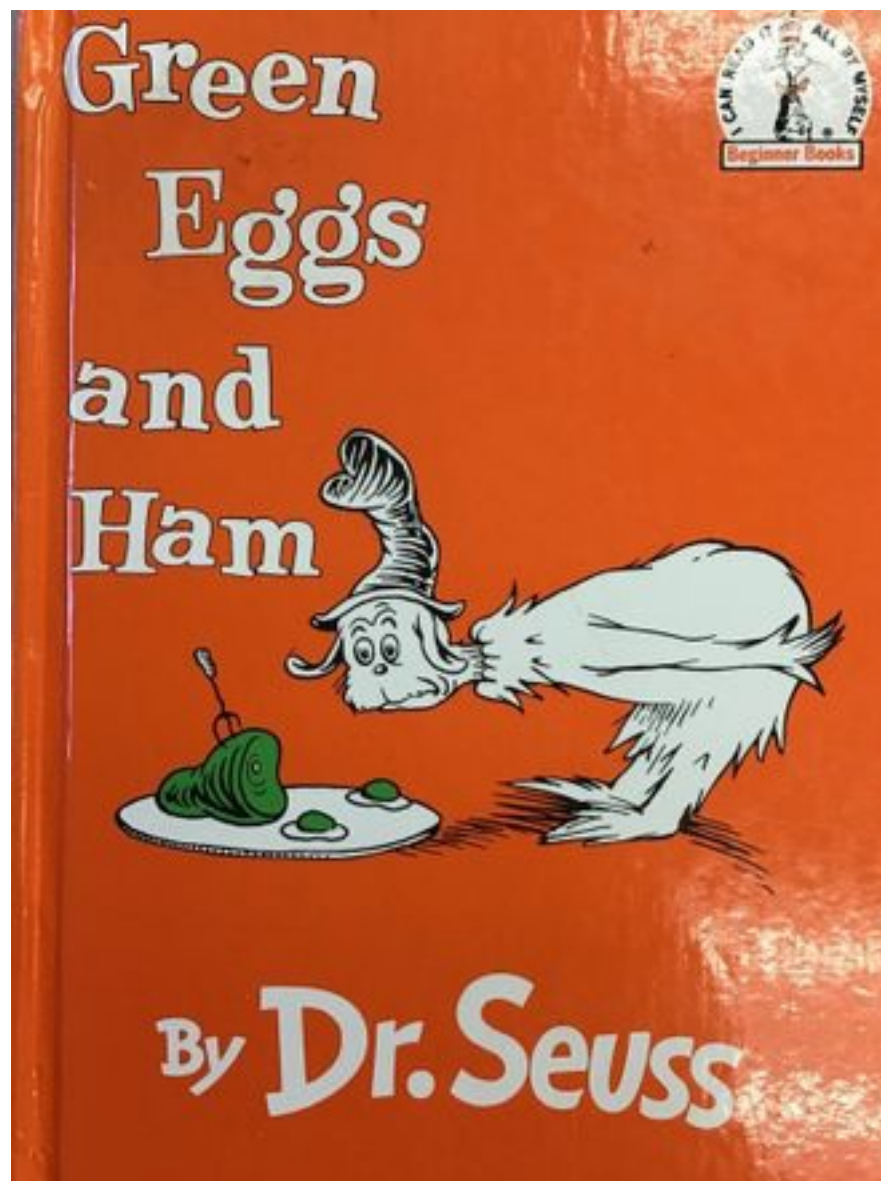


The Crayon Box That Talked by Shane DeRolf

Here are some suggested activities to do with your child this week.

Enjoy!

1. Look for letters around the house! Give your child a letter and see if she/he can find the letter in print somewhere in the house. On the wall, a book, mail on the table, etc...
2. Color a picture! Have your child use different colors and talk about the picture he/she is drawing. You can draw too and talk about your picture.
3. Make pancakes or other food together. Talk about the ingredients, how to measure. Have your child pour the ingredients. Use words such as "mixing" "pouring" "measuring" or other words to describe what you or your child are doing.
4. Count and eat! During a snack or meal, have your child count how many crackers/pretzels or item that he/she is eating. If he/she eats one, how many are left? Now two were eaten, how many are left?
5. Read books with rhyming words. Talk about words that sound the same (rhyme) and words that do not rhyme.
