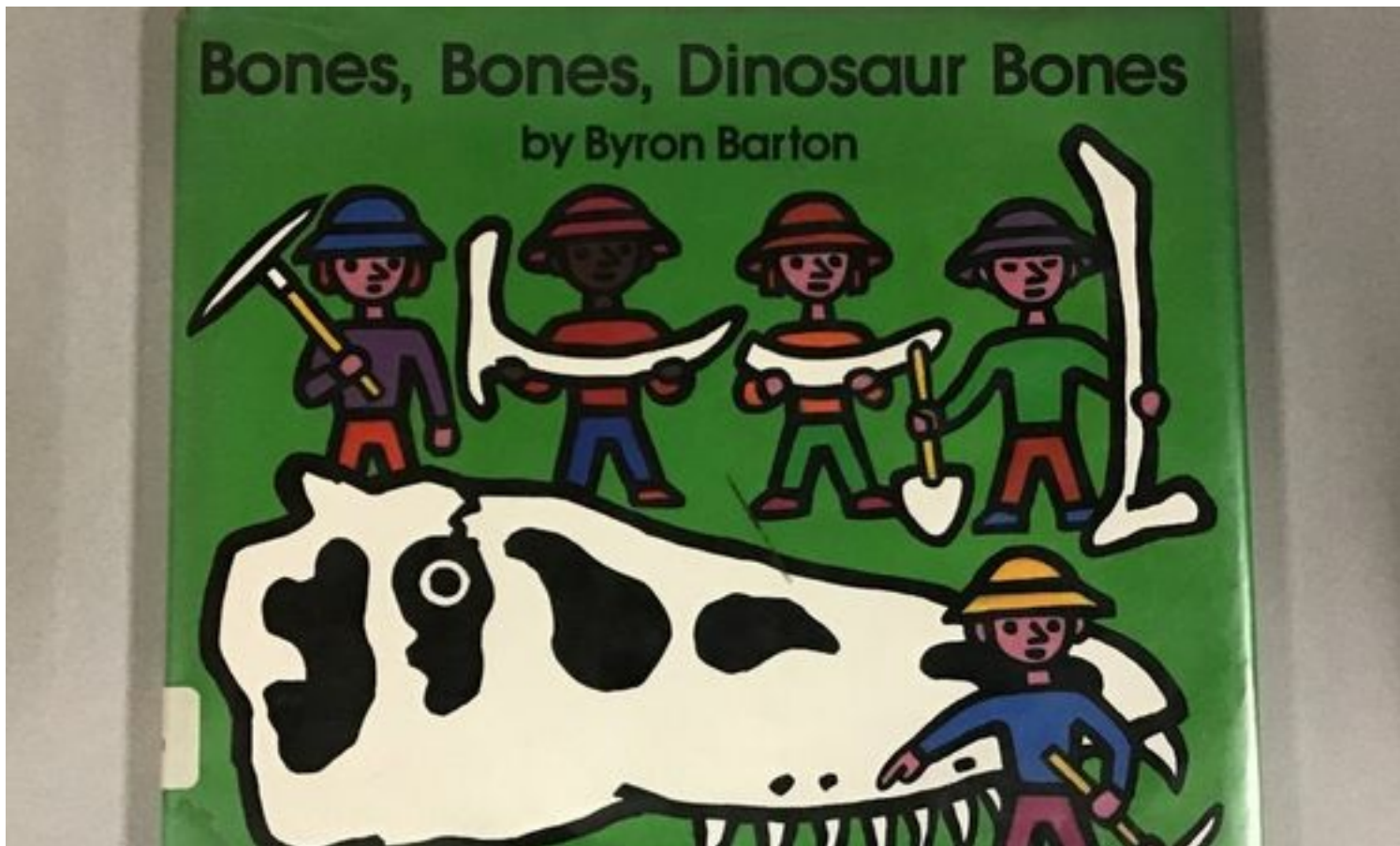


**Let It Rain by Maryann Cocca-Leffler**

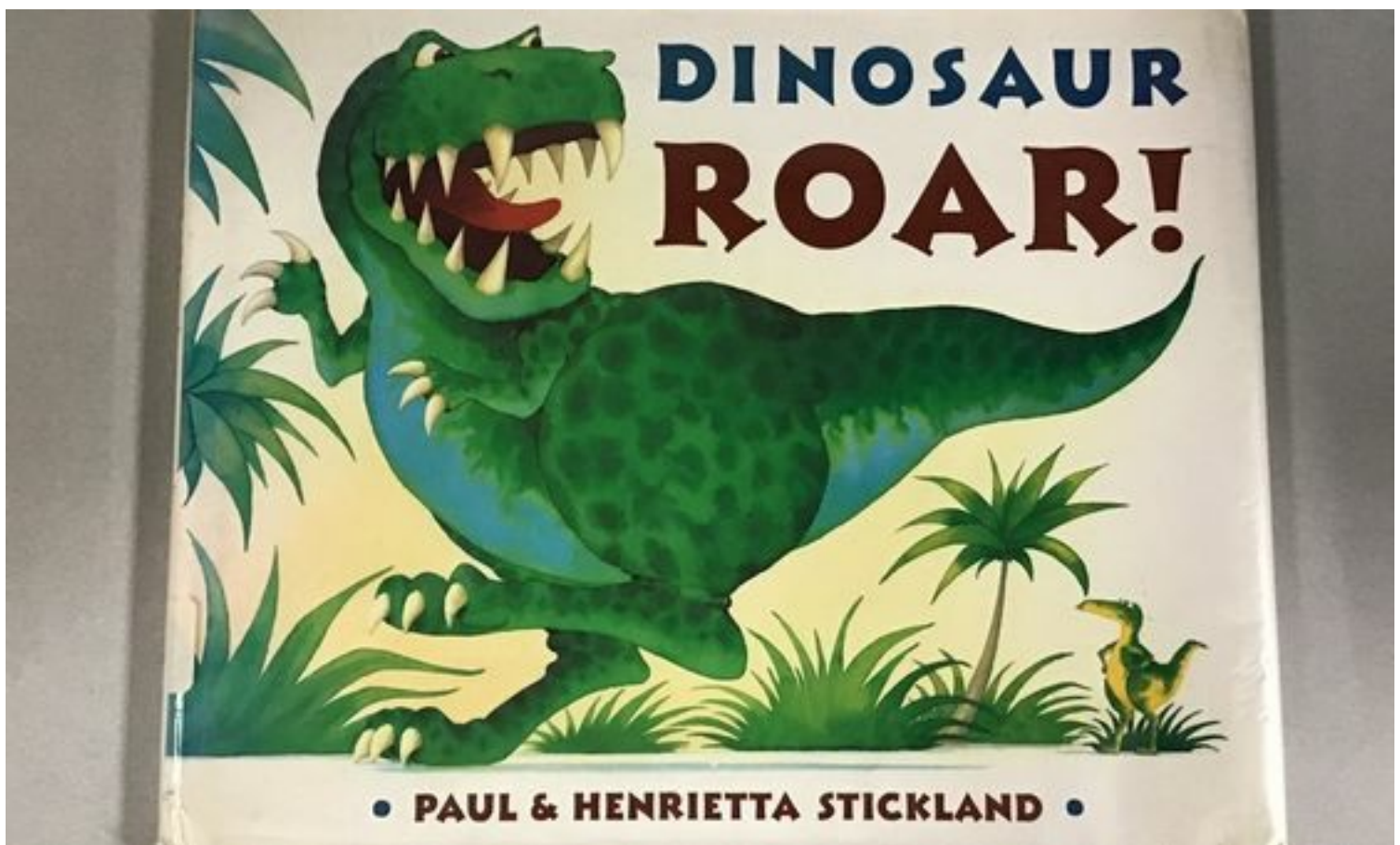


## **Bones Bones Dinosaur Bones by Byron Barton**

**Here are some suggested activities to do with your child this week. Enjoy!**

1. Make prints in play dough. Roll out play dough so it is flat. Then have your child walk a dinosaur, roll a car or train or other toys through the playdough. Talk about the prints the different toys leave in the play dough.
2. Practice cutting. Your child can snip the edges of paper or cut straight across a piece of paper. Help your child hold the scissors correctly and talk about safety with scissors.
3. Play I spy. Pick an item that is in the same room and in sight of your child. Give your child clues such as "I spy something red" or "I spy something you can eat" and see if your child can find what you "spy."
4. Line them up! Have your child line up stuffed animals, shoes or other items that are in different sizes. See if they can line them up from smallest to largest.
5. Talk about the food your child is eating. Is it soft? crunchy? sweet? spicy? fruit or vegetable? Etc...
