

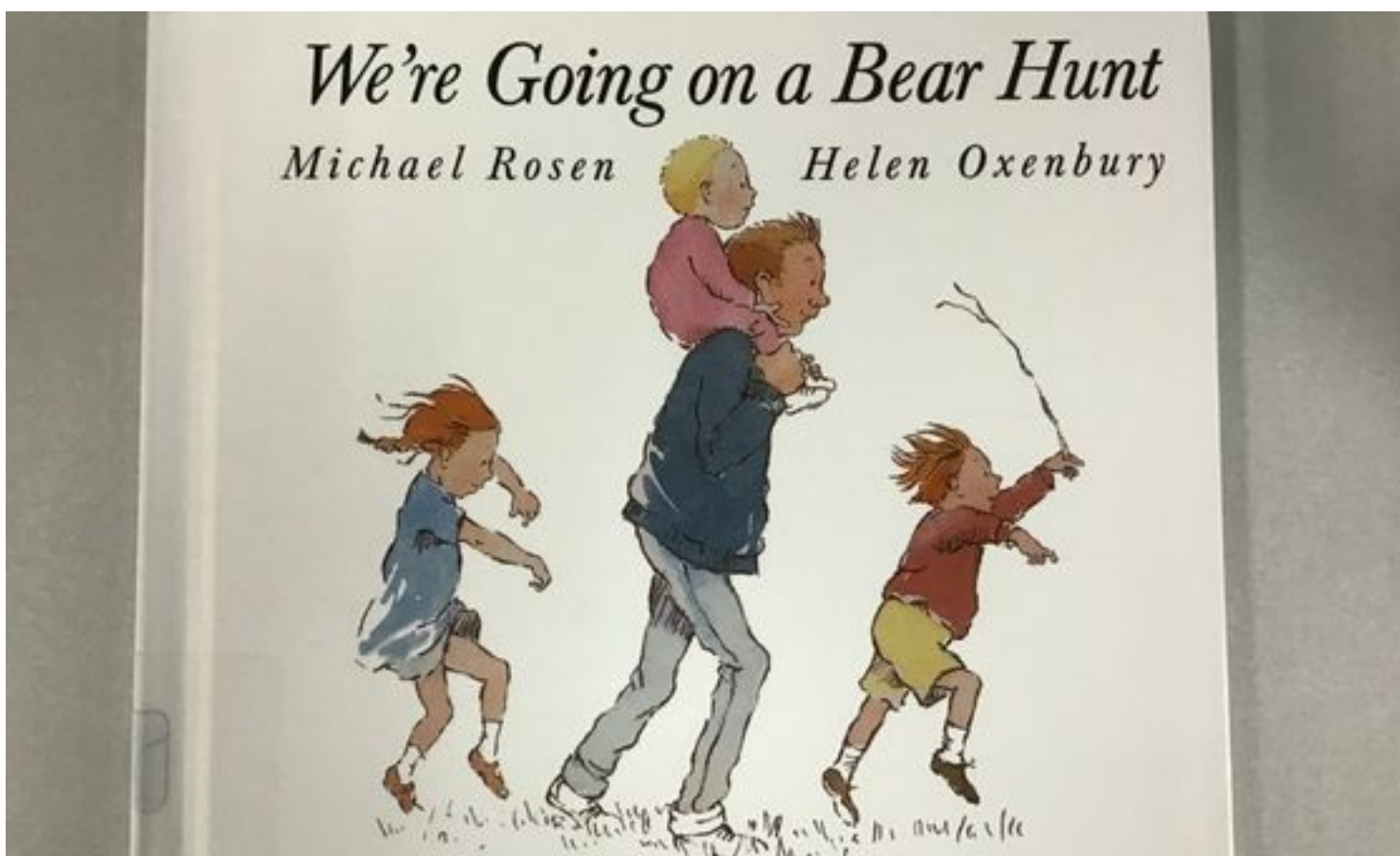


Week of March 8

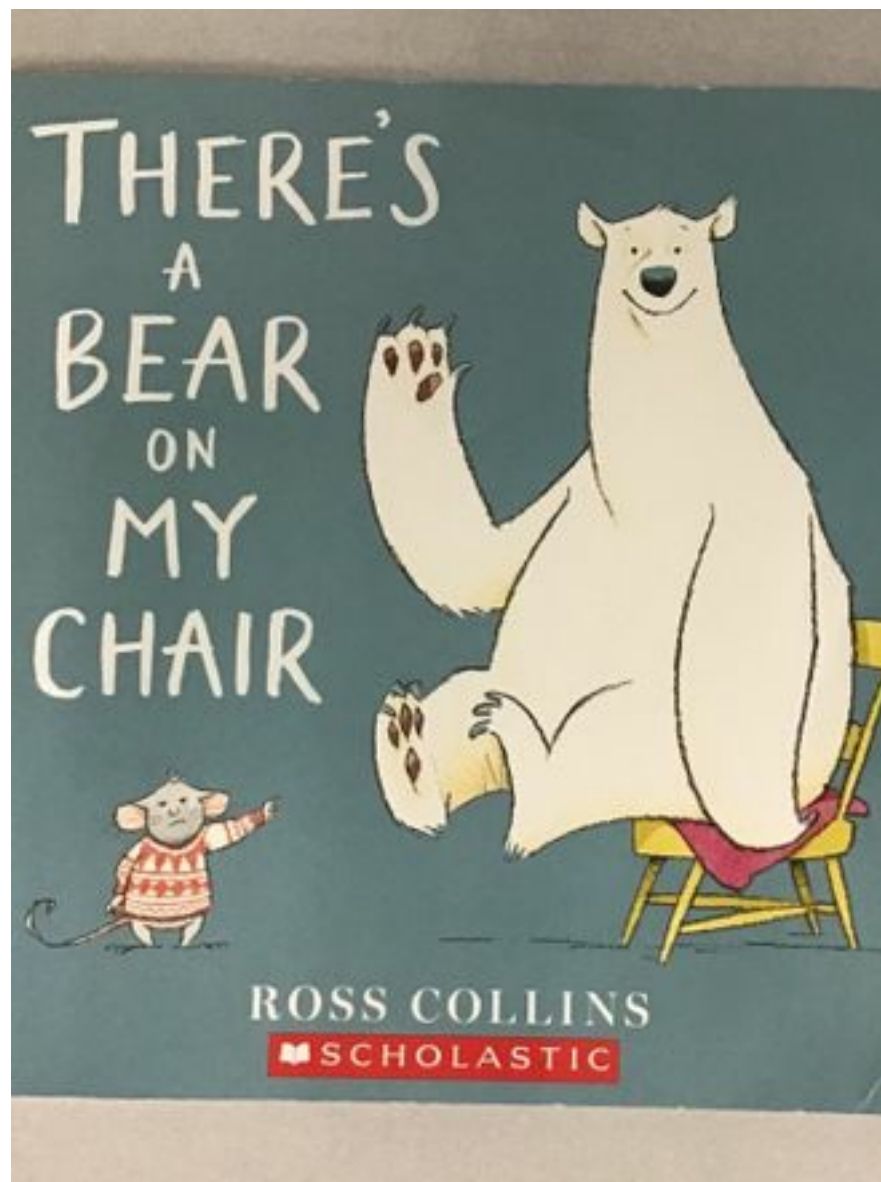


We're Going On A Bear Hunt by Michael Rosen

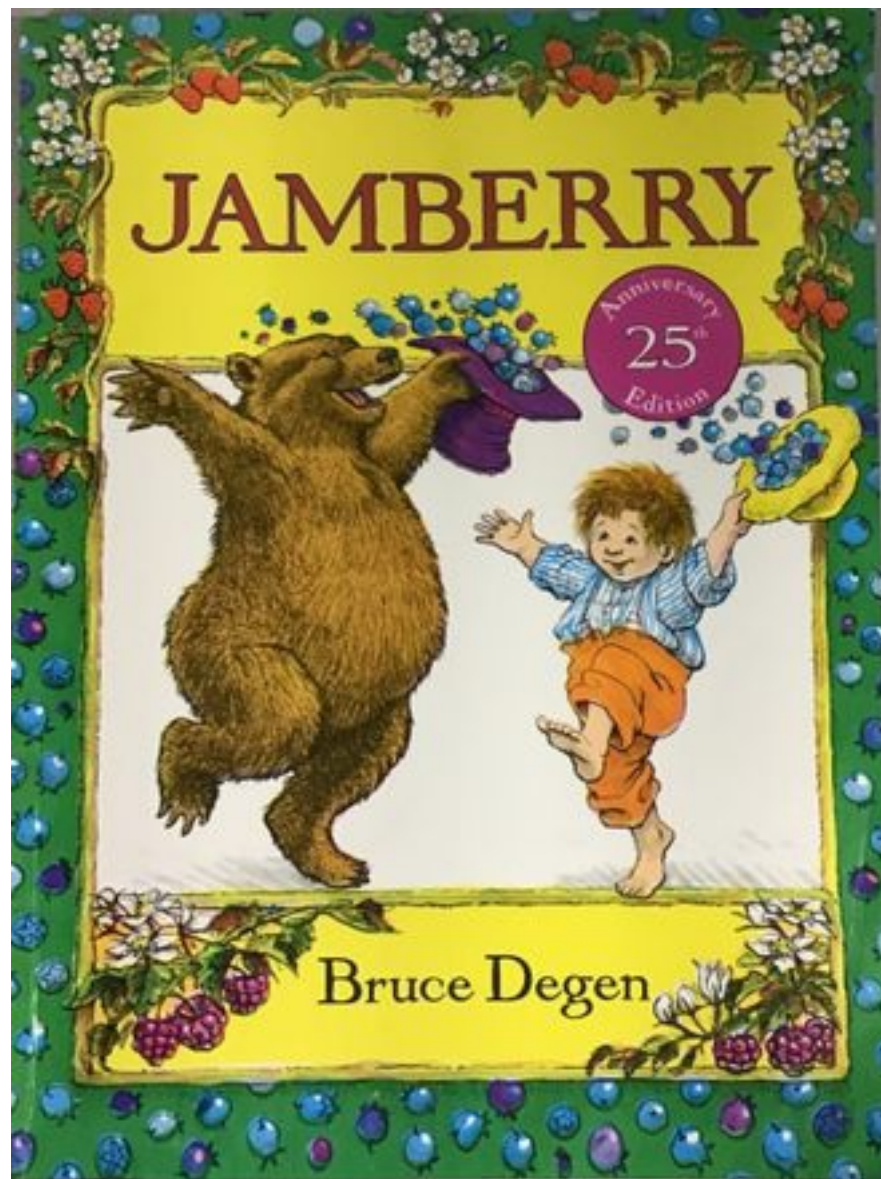


There's A Bear On My Chair by Ross Collins

Here are some suggested activities to do with your child this week.

Enjoy!

1. Make "long wavy grass" like in the Bear Hunt story! Have your child snip the edges of green paper.
2. Act out the bear hunt! Here is a link to the song.

3. Make an obstacle course around the house. Go over pillows, under the table, around the chair, etc... Talk about position words such as on, under, over, next to, behind, etc...
4. Make up a story about the food you are eating. For example, you are eating broccoli and say "Once upon a time, there was a tall stalk of broccoli...." and continue the story. Pause to allow your child to share what they think will happen in the story.
5. Count Off: In a loud voice, you start by saying the number "one". Your child will then say "two." Keep taking turns saying the next number. See how high you can count!
