

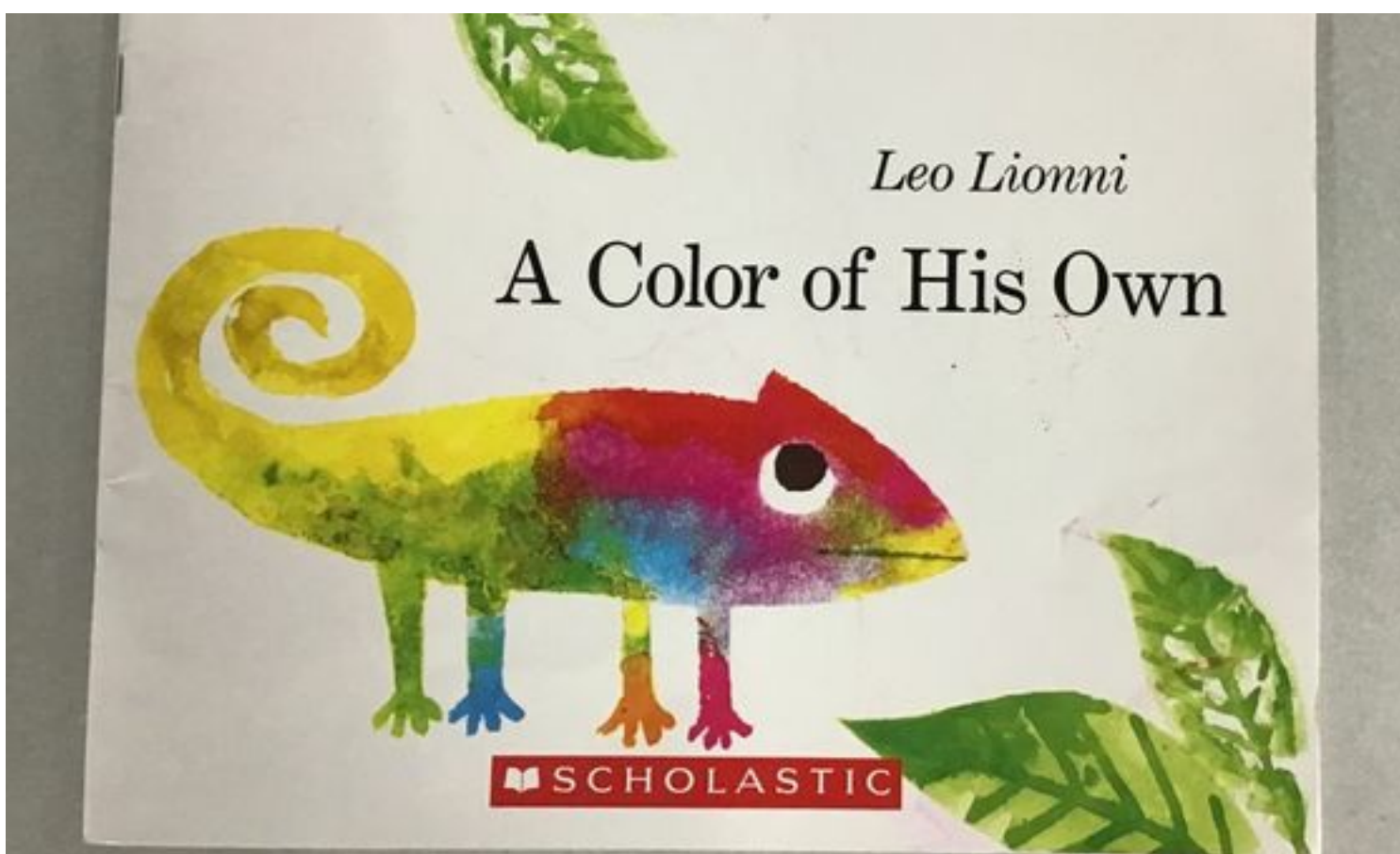


## Week of May 10

**Here are some suggested activities to do with your child this week. Enjoy!**

1. Talk about primary colors (red, yellow and blue) and mix

colors! Have your child pick two primary paint colors and then mix them together. What happens? Mix red/yellow, red/blue and yellow/red.

2. Make letters using play dough or pipe cleaners.

3. Draw "undercover." Tape paper on the underside of a table. Then have your child color/draw under the table.

4. Puddle Jumping! Put out pieces of blue paper and pretend they are puddles. Have your child jump over the puddles.

5. Talk about things that you can do in the warm weather and in the cold weather. Can you swim in the cold/winter? Can you go sledding in the summer/warm weather?
