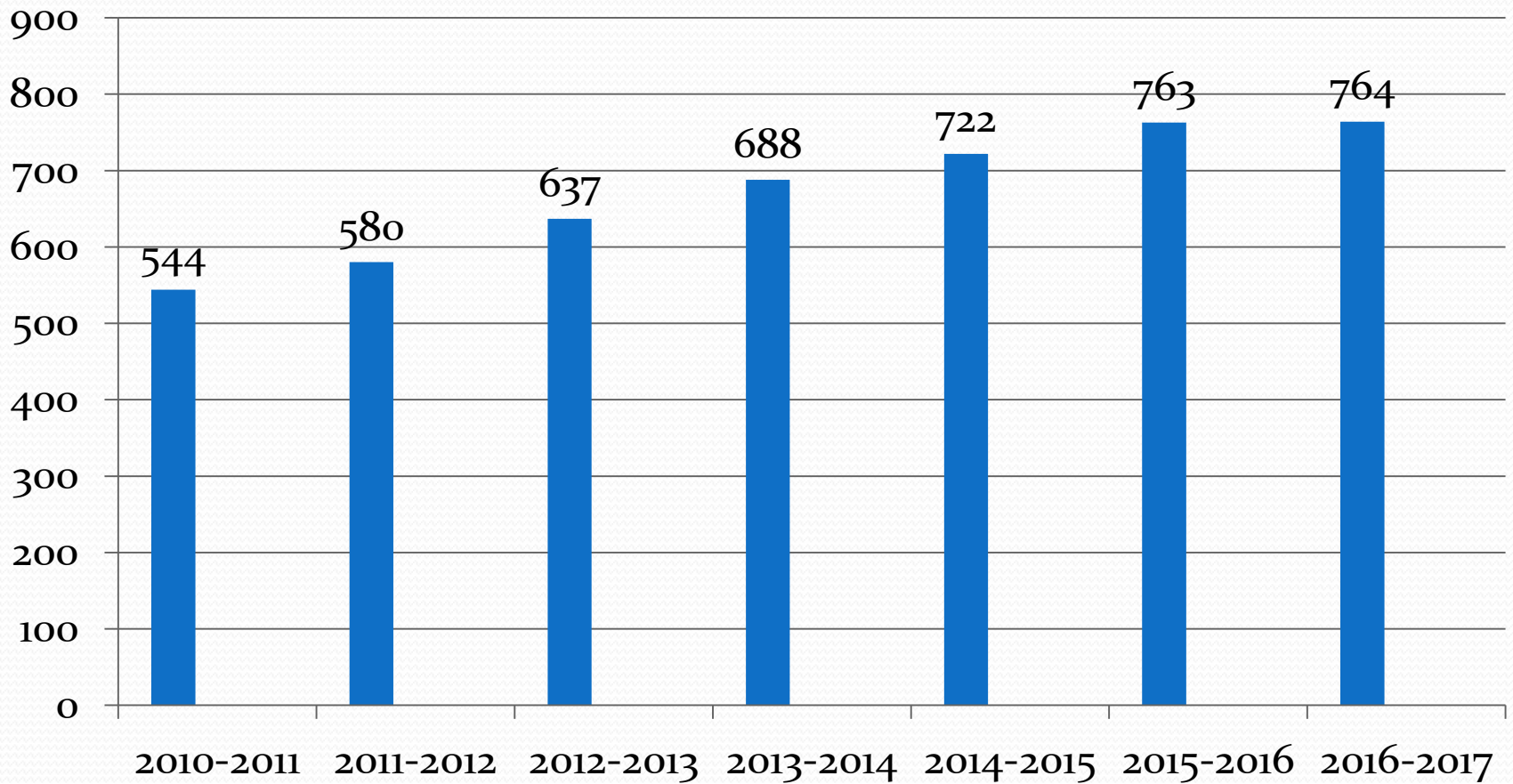

Tax Points & Assessed Values

- **A Tax Point (cent) in 2017 = \$77,000**
- **Average assessed value of home in Chesterfield 2017 = \$391,063**

Average Home Assessed Value is \$391,063

- **A home assessed at \$391,063 will see a \$36.42 tax decrease in the general fund.**
- **A home assessed at \$391,063 will see a \$128.33 tax increase in debt service.**
- **Total Tax Increase = \$91.91**
